

UGA Study Abroad Payment Information

Both tuition, including course-related fees such as the technology fee, and the program fee for participation (i.e., the room, board, and other non-instructional costs) will be billed directly by the UGA Student Accounts system after you are accepted into the program.

Program fees will be billed in stages beginning immediately after acceptance according to the **Program Fee schedule** in the box below. This is also done through the Bursar's office. You must make sure that it is credited to this study abroad class. Tuition will be billed according to the regular UGA payment calendar for tuition. Further payment instructions and details will be available when you register in OASIS.

NOTE: Please check your UGA MyID account frequently during the time between acceptance into the program and your departure. Notices about amounts due to Student Accounts and other official UGA announcements will *only* be sent to an official UGA MyID. If you normally use another e-mail provider, please make sure your UGA account is forwarded to that account.

Note: final summer tuition rates are not set until late April of each year; tuition rates quoted earlier may be subject to change.

⇒ Technology Fee: set each year

⇒ For *some* students: \$250 Out-of-state Board of Regent's Fee

This fee is waived for Georgia residents, whatever home university they attend. It is also waived for students enrolled at University System of Georgia schools and SEC member institutions, regardless of state of residence.

⇒ Application and (\$500 non-refundable deposit--due to Bursar's office after I submit your names so by 1 Feb) due by: 15 January 2010.

Students who withdraw after 15 April are obligated to pay the full program amount.

⇒ Second installment of \$2000 due by: 1 March.

⇒ Third and final installment of \$2000 due by: 15 April.

Refund Information

⇒ If a student withdraws from program on or before 15 March, then student will receive a full refund of all fees minus the \$500 deposit.

⇒ If a student withdraws from program between 15 March and 15 April, then student will receive a refund of all fees minus \$500 deposit and all fees already paid by program on behalf of student.

- ⇒ If a student withdraws from program on or after 15 April, no refund will be made to student of any fees paid. If the program is cancelled due to insufficient student enrollment, then a full refund of monies paid will be given to each student.
- ⇒ If the program is cancelled due to an act of war or terrorism, a State Department warning or other circumstances that make the program location unsafe, all monies not already spent on behalf of the student will be refunded to each student.
- ⇒ All requests for refunds should be made in writing to the program director.
